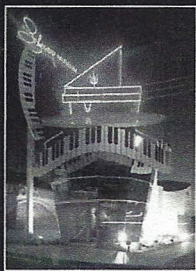

Mac King Follows His Dreams To Stardom

One part of the show that makes King stand out from the rest, besides his interesting attire, is the infamous goldfish trick. The magician swallows the goldfish—whole and alive. After the initial shock has worn off and the audience is given just the right amount of time to forget about the poor fish, it reappears unharmed.

Another trick takes the cake—literally. King somehow makes a Fig Newton cookie vanish then appear out of nowhere.

In another favorite act, the magician dons what he calls his cloak of invisibility. King puts on a raincoat, then creeps around the crowd proclaiming that when his “cloak” is on, he's invisible. He might not be completely invisible, but watching him is completely comical.

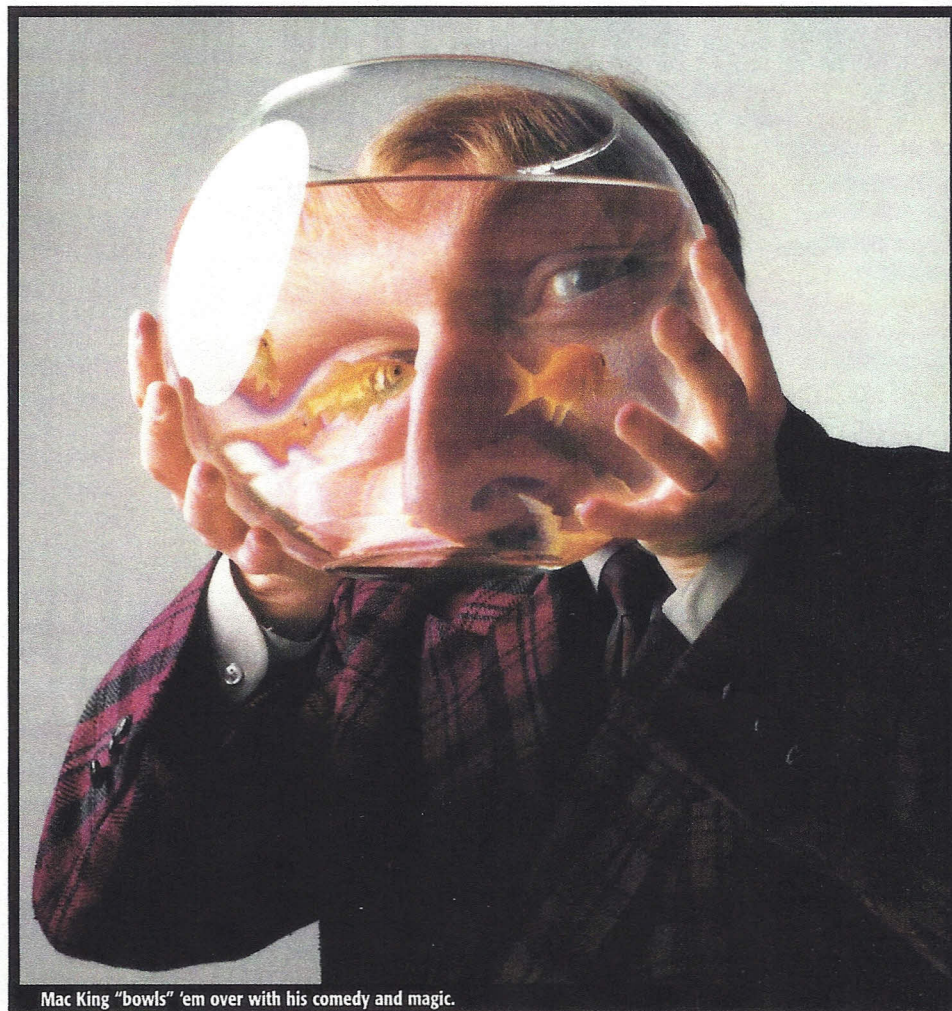
